COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. This show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the United States Rules for Working Equitation. The rules can be found at www.usawe.org/rules.
- 2. ASTM/SEI approved headgear required for all competitors when mounted.
- 3. Rider's choice of attire should be neat and presentable. Boots and/or half-chaps, breeches or western jeans, collared shirts are permitted. Polos are fine; jackets not required.
- 4. Sleeveless shirts or tank tops are not permitted.
- 5. The competition number must be displayed while the horse is under saddle.
- 6. A horse may be entered twice in a competition if ridden by two different riders and in different levels. Exceptions: Two Youth riders can use the same horse in the Intro level. Other exceptions are at the discretion of the show management.

- All out of state horses must show the office a Certificate of Veterinary Health before unloading horse from trailer.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCATION OF COMPETITION:

- Dressage Trial will be held in the outdoor sand arena.
- Ease of Handling and Speed Trials will be held in the indoor arena at Frying Pan Farm Park (FPFP)
- Warm up will be in the outdoor warm up arena. Riders can warm up in the grassy areas if they choose.

RIDE TIMES:

- In Working Equitation, all rides are by "Order of Go".
- Approximate Dressage Ride times will be emailed to the competitors Wednesday before the show.
- Competitors are advised to recheck the day sheet upon arrival as last-minute changes to the schedule may occur.
- Riders may walk the courses at designated times before the EOH Trial and the Speed Trial.

RIBBONS/PRIZES

- Ribbons will be awarded from 1st to 6th place in each trial of each level.
- Overall Ribbons: Champion & Reserve Champion will be awarded for each division provided there are at least two riders in that level. L2 & Up- must complete at least two of the three trials to be awarded a Champion or Reserve Champion ribbon.
- NOVAWE High Score Ribbon awarded for highest score in the Dressage Trial.

TRAILER PARKING

- Parking will be in the lower gravel lot or in the area behind the Indoor.
- Please take your manure and loose hay home with you.
- Bring water and hay for your horse.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- · Pets must be leashed.
- Bring your own food and water.
- Show is limited to 20 participants/rides.
- Change Policy: Changes to level, division, rider, or horse are not permitted after Closing Date.
- Refund Policy: No refunds after Closing Date. Participants who scratch or withdraw before the Closing Date will be reimbursed their entry fee minus \$20 Office Fee.
- The Dressage & EOH scores from competitors will go towards NOVAWE's Year End Awards Program.
