- 2. Frying Pan Farm Park April 4-April 6, 2025 Dates Contract Received.
 - a. Discussion on how to best use these dates: Potential for 1 day show, schooling or licensed. Could do a combination of clinics or shows. The feeling is that a clinic and schooling show would be a good option for this time of year. The plan will be to use the days of April 5th and 6th for a clinic followed by a schooling show.
- 3. 2025 Plans What would you like for NOVAWE to host? Since regionals are not until mid-October, NOVAWE will look at a one-day licensed show in September. Biddie will plan to reach out to FPFP for dates available. It would be nice to have a few additional clinics with local instructors. Potentially change a clinic format to offer course walking instruction, etc. The format idea is no more than 3 riders per group. Biddie will reach out to FPFP about a one-day clinic in March. Mills will check her calendar for a date she could do a clinic in March.
